SPRING 2023 ELECTION CODE REVISIONS

1 2 3 4	WHEREAS	Article I Section 3(1) of the SMU Student Senate Election Code encourages the Senate to review and revise the election code yearly, prior to the election, and
5 6 7 8	ACKNOWLEDGING	that our election code aims to uphold principles of good governance, respect for others, and stewardship of public accountability, and
9 10 11	RECOGNIZING	that both peer institutions and SMU precedent have set strong standards for good governance.
12 13 14 15	BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED	that the Election Chair shall create an Advisory Opinion Request process, which requires candidates to formally request clarification of the election code in written form and requires the Membership Chair to share their responses with all candidates.
17 18 19 20 21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED	that the Endorsement Policy shall be eased to allow for more widespread endorsements, including on social media and other communication channels, except for those who have served or currently serve as a Student Body Officer or Senate Officer.
22 23 24 25 26 27 28	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED	that a clear policy outlining the importance of respecting other candidates shall be implemented as follows: "A Candidate or Campaign Worker may under no circumstances intentionally interfere with the campaign of another Candidate in any way. Engaging in any form of negative campaigning, including, but not limited to, defamation of character, libel, slander, or altering an opponent's campaign materials is strictly prohibited."
29 30 31 32 33 34	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED	that expense limits shall be updated to match current economic conditions, specifically to include an expense limit of \$300 for Student Body Officer positions and \$150 for Student Senator positions.
35 36 37 38 39	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED	that the Membership Committee shall publicly post any complaints heard by the committee in which candidates were found responsible for said violations, alongside the Committee's response.

40 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a table detailing special-interest Senator positions, including 41 who is eligible to run and vote for each role, shall be added to 42 the Election Code to clarify existing precedent. 43 44 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that existing precedents relating to election complaint submissions 45 and referrals by the Membership Chair and Student Senate 46 advisor shall be added to the code in writing. 47 48 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that other minor word choice changes or clarifications of existing 49 precedent, such as requiring the submission of certain requests in 50 writing, shall also be included in the updated Election Code. 51 52 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED The 109th Student Senate will adopt the attached Election Code 53 for the Spring 2023 election cycle, as well as any subsequent 54 elections, until modified.
